The application is lengthy and students are inquired to start early. Requires two teacher letters of recommendation and three essays. <i>Competition is rigorous.</i> 20 scholarships awarded. <i>Note: SPA does not rank and</i> <i>it is not required for the application.</i>
Scottsdale Leadership -Jenkins Youth Leadership Award	Deadline: September 15, 2017	Students who demonstrate exceptional leadership in the community. Limited to students who attend a school located in Scottsdale. Students can be nominated by an adult, other than a parent, familiar with their leadership activities. If you feel you are qualified, contact an adult and ask them if they will nominate you by the deadline date. Both nominators and nominees must submit an application. A SPA student won in 2015. Two delegates are selected from every state. A \$10,000 scholarship is awarded. Test is administered at the school based upon the knowledge of U.S. and local government.
