- 10th Grade Latin V (4 credits per semester, Eligibility: 10th grade students with 2.5+ GPA, Semester 1: August-December, Semester 2: January-May)
- **11th Grade Calculus I** (4 credits per year, Eligibility: 11th grade students with 3.0+ GPA, Full Year: August-May)
- 12th Grade Greek II (4 credits per semester, Eligibility: 12th grade students with 2.5+ GPA, Semester 1: August-December, Semester 2: January-May)
- **12th Grade Spanish IV** (4 credits per semester, Eligibility: 12th grade students with 2.5+ GPA, Semester 1: August-December, Semester 2: January-May)
- 12th Grade French IV (4 credits per semester, Eligibility: 12th grade students with 2.5+ GPA, Semester 1: August-December, Semester 2: January-May)
- 12th Grade Humane Letters IV (3 credits per semester, Eligibility: 12th grade students with 3.0+ GPA, Semester 1: August-December, Semester 2: January-May)

# College Credit Options

## CLEP TESTS

Students must earn a passing score to receive college credit for the test, which varies by college. It is recommended students take only the test(s) they are most confident in and invest ample time studying. Not all colleges will accept CLEP exams. Before taking CLEP, research each college's CLEP policy and course equivalency guide.

Free study resource available through **ModernStates.org**. Upon successful completion, students receive a voucher for a free CLEP test.

## DUAL ENROLLMENT

Dual enrollment can be earned in 10th and 11th grade math courses and 12th grade Humane Letters through Southeastern University. Great Hearts students must have a 3.0 unweighted cumulative or higher GPA to participate. Dual enrollment for 10th and 12th grade language courses can be earned through Arizona Christian University each semester. Great Hearts students must have a 2.5 unweighted cumulative or higher GPA to participate. Please note that grades earned through dual enrollment become part of the student's permanent college record/transcript. It is the responsibility of the student to research and determine how their dual enrollment credits may or may not transfer to their future 4-year college or university. After registration is complete and paid on Configio, NO REFUNDS will be issued. If you have questions about which option is best for you, please consult with your Great Hearts college counselor before purchasing.

## AP EXAMS

Students do not need to be enrolled in an AP class to take the AP exam; however, Great Hearts courses do not precisely align with AP curriculum. It is recommended students invest time to prepare for the exam. In order to receive credit for an AP test, students typically need to score at least a 3, 4, or 5.
