

# **Preparing for Takeoff**



#### Arrive at the airport

When we arrive at the airport, we will stay together as a group!

Be sure to arrive in clothes that you will be wearing when we hit the ground running.



#### Check In

I will be checking our group in. Please do not check in online.

Travelers 18+ will need a Government Issued Real ID\* to fly.

\*Real ID will be required in all states within the US (including Puerto Rico) for travel effective May 7, 2025. If you do not already have your Real ID, adults 18+ will need to make sure this in updated before your tour date to make it through airport security.



#### Security

We will all go through security after checkin.

Anything we take must comply with TSA restrictions.

We may need to take larger electronics out of our bags or take our shoes off.



#### **Boarding**

We will wait at our gate before we board.

Boarding often starts around half an hour before our flight, so it's important that we get there early!



#### **Arrival**

Our Tour Director will meet us upon arrival, and we will hop right on the bus!

It's important that we have anything we may need for the day in our carry-on or in our backpacks.

## Just in case



We're seeing more travel disruptions than in past years, and EF is hearing from trusted industry partners that this trend is likely to continue. While EF makes every effort to minimize these disruptions, it's important to keep you informed about what to expect and provide suggestions to ensure we are prepared in the event of a delay.

Steps I will take as your Group Leader:

- I will speak directly with the airline to get information about our options as they are responsible for rebooking our flight if necessary.
- Myself or one of our chaperones will share updates with you all via our designated on-tour communication channel.
- I will communicate itinerary updates directly with EF, so they are aware and can make changes accordingly. To help streamline communication, there is no need for you to call EF as well unless you have a personal emergency separate from our delay.

Steps our travelers and families should take:

- Travelers should save receipts from expenses incurred during a delay as they will be necessary for potential insurance claims or reimbursements. See policy for coverage detail.
- While never ideal, when faced with disruptions, our most important jobs are to stay calm, be flexible, and keep a positive attitude (we're going on an amazing adventure, after all!).

## **Pack Light**

We are responsible for loading our luggage on and off the bus and into our hotels. Remember to leave room for souvenirs if you plan on shopping.

## Baggage

Be sure to pack everything you need for the first day in your personal item, as we won't check into our hotel until the end of the day. Carry any valuables, personal items and/or medications in your EF backpack or carry-on.

## Clothing

The weather on tour may be different from what we're used to at home. Be sure to check the weather and bring layers in case you get cold or warm throughout the day. We will be touring rain or shine! Pack two comfortable shoes at the most! This will save room (and weight!) in your suitcase.

## Snacks

We will do LOTS of walking! Be sure to have a reusable water bottle so that you can stay hydrated. If you have any allergies, or think you may get hungry between meals, feel free to bring extra snacks!





## WHAT TO BRINI

To help you prepare for your upcoming Service Learning Tour, here is a full list of things to bring and keep in mind while working in and visiting local communities. While you're packing, remember: service isn't about flair so please bring only what you need.

You will be outdoors and working hard during your trip, so please bring clothing that you do not mind getting dirty. You should check the local weather before departing, and remember to dress appropriately for the outdoor activities you'll be doing.

- A list of important phone numbers and addresses to send postcards home


#### **SNACKS:**

#### Carry-on bag

Your EF backpack is a perfect carry-on bag. Here's a short list of things you might need on the first day of the trip. These should be packed in the carry-on in case the checked luggage is delayed.


- □ Cash

## **Participation**

## **Prohibited & Illegal Activity**

Smoking and alcohol use are prohibited. Any illegal activity will result in automatic dismissal from tour. You will be sent home at your own expense. Beyond your assigned roommates, visitors or other group members are prohibited from entering your room.



## Meals

Breakfast will be provided by our hotel each morning. Lunch will often be on-thego (lunch money is not included on tour). Our Tour Director will provide local, affordable options along the way. Dinner will vary each night!

- Promptly communicate with your chaperones if there is a problem.




#### **EF Tour Director:**





EF is cashless! See QR code below to download.

Before the trip: Till cards can be loaded by parents ahead of the trip to help their kid practice getting comfortable using their Till card (and can add funds for extra expenses like souvenirs and gifts).

On the trip: Parents and students can check their balance on the app and load more money onto their students' card. Safe and seamless!
